## COURSE DESCRIPTION

The one-day Sickle Cell Disease conference will provide information about current trends in the field and available resources for healthcare providers, patients, family members, care givers, and social services providers. The morning session is devoted to healthcare providers with CME credit available. The afternoon session is tailored for patients, family members and social service providers and is not eligible for CME credit.

- Describe indications where red blood cell exchange may be preferable to transfusion and be able to apply that knowledge for improved patient outcomes; and
