Dr. Saver is a behavioral/cognitive and vascular neurologist dedicated to improving brain health through research advances and clinical care.

His major research interests are the neurocognitive consequences of brain vascular disease, acute stroke treatment, stroke prevention, brain imaging, and clinical trial design. Dr. Saver has authored over 870 research articles, three books and 40 book chapters. He served as principal investigator of the NIH-NINDS FAST-MAG trial, Global Co-PI of the SWIFT PRIME trial, and Chair of the American Heart Association Stroke Council.
