Liana G. Apostolova, MD, MSc, FAAN joined the IU School of Medicine as a The Barbara and Peer Baekgaard Professor in Alzheimer's Disease Research and Professor in Neurology, Radiology, Medical and Molecular Genetics at in June of 2015. Her research focuses on the early symptomatic and presymptomatic stages of Alzheimer's disease and on the development and validation of sensitive imaging and genetic biomarkers for Alzheimer's disease and other dementing disorders.

Daniel R. Bateman, MD, Assistant Professor **of Psychiatry**, works with persons with cognitive impairment, major neurocognitive disorders, older adults with mental illness and family caregivers. He helps patients and families navigate the complexities, treatment options, disease course and current medical understandings of neurocognitive disorders and mental illness. His research focuses on the treatment of neuropsychiatric symptoms (depression, anxiety, psychosis, irritability) associated with dementia and pre-dementia syndromes.
